Online applications will open to all COAS students.

November 8

Online applications will close. No exceptions

November 8-December 5

The COAS Scholarship Committee will review and deliberate on applications.

05 December 10 January 15-30 February 5-**January 15**

Office of the Dean sends finalist applicant list to respective HU units for review + approval.

Award & rejection letters will be sent out via email to applicants. Students accept award letters via online.

> The scholarship will be withdrawn if the award letter is not accepted by the due date.

Collection of students' banking/financial paperwork

Failure to submit paperwork to the Office of the Dean within this timeline will result in your award to be withdrawn.

May 10

Scholarship funds are processed and dispersed.

You can expect this process to take up to 60 days. This process is not handled by the Office of the Dean. Your patience is appreciated.


