

COAS CEREMONY DETAILS

Graduates must be both academically and financially cleared to participate in graduation festivities. Regalia is required for all ceremonies.

The Graduation Recognition Ceremonies for the College of Arts and Sciences will be held on:

Thursday, May 8, 2025, In Burr Gymnasium.

- The ceremony for Natural Sciences will be held from 8 am-11 am.
- (Graduates MUST arrive in the Lower Gym by 7:00 am, processional begins at 7:30 am)
- The ceremony for **Social Sciences** & **Humanities** will be held from 1 pm-3 pm.
- (Graduates MUST arrive in the Lower Gym by 12:00 pm, processional begins at 12:30 pm)

Graduates will receive 4 guest tickets, and 1 graduate ticket

The COAS Graduation Recognition Ceremonies celebrate all graduates of the College of Arts and Sciences. During these ceremonies, COAS students will have the opportunity to walk across the stage and receive their diploma covers. There will be two separate ceremonies: one for graduates in the Natural Sciences and another for those in the Social Sciences and Humanities.

- Graduates are expected to arrive by 7 a.m. to line up for the processional.
- Doors will open to all guests at 7:30 a.m.
- The processional will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m.
- Ceremony will begin at 10:00 am

LATIN HONORS POLICY & DISTINCTION

LATIN HONORS POLICY

- These honors will appear on student transcripts, diplomas, and in the commencement program.
- Honors eligibility grades in non-credit courses are not considered in determining eligibility for honors.
- Students are NOT eligible to receive honors distinctions if:
 - The last half (60 hours) if coursework required for the degree was not completed in residence at Howard University
 - Course(s) were repeated (received a letter grade)
 - They have not been enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for each semester enrolled, with the exception of the last semester in residence.

COAS GRADUATION CEREMONIES

The college will be distributing tickets for the COAS ceremonies to prospective graduates who have met the academic and financial requirements to participate in the ceremonies.

- Graduates will receive 4 guest tickets AND 1 graduate ticket for the COAS graduation ceremonies.
- Everyone must have a ticket to enter the venue INCLUDING GRADUATES (Graduates will receive a ticket for themselves).

 Small children who can sit in an adults lap will not need a ticket (2 years old and under)

(The ceremonies will also be streamed live for others to view)
