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Your Degree Breakdown:

- Major Requirements: 30+ Afro-American Studies credits (10+ courses)
- General Education: 60+ credits (approximately 24 courses)
- Intro to Statistics is Required
- Free Electives: 30 credits to reach 120 (General Electives)
- Complete all 7 ELOs (can overlap with courses)
- Undergraduate Comprehensive Exam

Important: Double-Dipping Made Simple!

One course can fulfill BOTH a General Education requirement AND an Essential Learning Outcome (ELO) at the same time. You don't need separate courses for each! This helps you graduate efficiently without taking extra classes.

Major credits **cannot** be double dipped with minor credits. Minors require **15-18 credits that are not applied to their major requirements**. Minor coursework must remain distinct and separate from major coursework.

University-Wide Requirements

- **Minimum GPA:** 2.0 for all undergraduate coursework
- **Residency:** Complete last 30 credits at Howard University
- **Exit Requirement:** Undergraduate Comprehensive Exam
- **Total Credits:** 120 credits required

Key Requirements

- **Minimum Major GPA:** 2.0
- **Credits in African Studies:** 30+ minimum

- **Foreign Language:** 9 credits in the same language required (3 credits can be intercultural)
- **Statistics:** MATH 009 required
- **Residency:** Last 30 credits at Howard University
- **General Education:** Must span at least 4 different disciplines

Important Notes

- **Introduction Course:** AFST 101 is required and should be taken in the first semester.
- **Internship:** AFST 183 provides hands-on experience. Plan early with your advisor.
- **Directed Research:** AFST 184 allows original research under faculty supervision.
- **Global Experience:** Can be satisfied through study abroad or diversity learning courses.
- Consult with your academic advisor each semester for course planning.
- **Minimum Minor GPA:** 2.0 if declared (15 credits minimum)
