- **Morning Ceremony: 8 am-10 am.**
- (Graduates **MUST** arrive in the Lower Gym by 7:00 am, processional begins at 7:30 am)
- **Afternoon Ceremony: 1 pm-3 pm.**
- (Graduates **MUST** arrive in the Lower Gym by 12:00 pm, processional begins at 12:30 pm)

- The processional will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m.
- Ceremony will begin at 10:00 am

During this formal event, graduates are recognized collectively, hear remarks from university leadership and distinguished speakers, and take part in time-honored traditions marking the completion of their degrees.

LATIN HONORS POLICY

- These honors will appear on student transcripts, diplomas, and in the commencement program.
- Honors eligibility grades in non-credit courses are not considered in determining eligibility for honors.
- **Students are NOT eligible to receive honors distinctions if:**
 - The last half (60 hours) of coursework required for the degree was not completed in residence at Howard University
 - Course(s) were repeated (received a letter grade)
 - They have not been enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for each semester enrolled, with the exception of the last semester in residence.
