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Your Degree Breakdown:

- Major Requirements: 33+ Afro-American Studies credits (10+ courses)
- General Education: 60+ credits (approximately 24 courses)
- Math Requirements: Two courses MATH 005 or higher (6-8 credits)
- Free Electives: 30 credits to reach 120 (General Electives)
- Complete all 7 ELOs (can overlap with courses)
- Undergraduate Comprehensive Exam

Important: Double-Dipping Made Simple!

One course can fulfill BOTH a General Education requirement AND an Essential Learning Outcome (ELO) at the same time. You don't need separate courses for each! This helps you graduate efficiently without taking extra classes.

Major credits **cannot** be double dipped with minor credits. Minors require **15-18 credits that are not applied to their major requirements**. Minor coursework must remain distinct and separate from major coursework.

University-Wide Requirements

- **Minimum GPA:** 2.0 for all undergraduate coursework
- **Residency:** Complete last 30 credits at Howard University
- **Exit Requirement:** Undergraduate Comprehensive Exam
- **Total Credits:** 120 credits required

Key Requirements

- **Minimum Major GPA:** 2.0
- **Minimum Minor GPA:** 2.0 (if declared, min 15 credits)
- **Credits in Afro-American Studies:** 33+ minimum
- **Foreign Language:** 9 credits in the same language required
- **Mathematics:** Two courses MATH 005 or higher required
- **Residency:** Last 30 credits at Howard University
- **General Education:** Must span at least 4 different disciplines

Important Notes

- **Introduction Sequence:** AFRO 005 and AFRO 006 are required and should be taken in the first year.
- **Senior Seminar:** AFRO 159 integrates your learning and should be taken in your final year.
- **Practicum/Internship:** AFRO 176 provides hands-on experience. Plan early with your advisor.
- **Writing Practicum:** AFRO 775 develops advanced writing skills for the discipline.
- **Foreign Language:** All 12 credits must be in the same language.
- Consult with your academic advisor each semester for course planning.
